




Povilas's TOP 5 toys at home: a dog, a brown teddy, a white teddy, a rabbit and a wolf.

Look and chant:

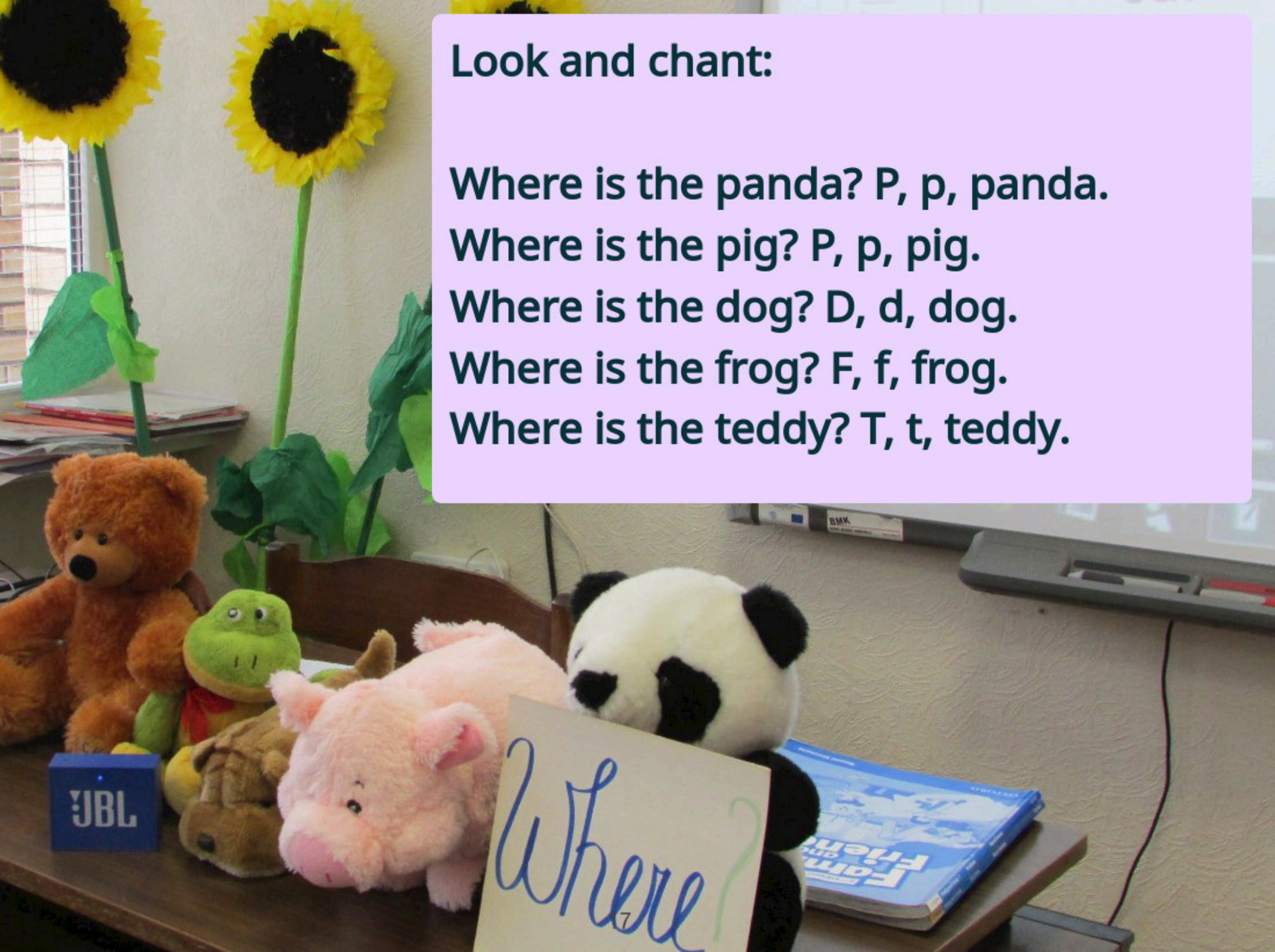
Where is the panda? P, p, panda.
